HISTORY: Patient exhibited chronic allergic dermatitis since 6 months of age, with recurring secondary pyoderma. Skin scraping was negative; allergen testing showed responses to environmental allergies, including trees, grasses, and molds.

Treatments during her first 7 years of age included immunotherapy, topical corticosteroids and antibiotics, oral corticosteroids and antibiotics, immunosuppresants, and medicated shampoos.

Diets previously fed included Iams[™] Veterinary Formula[™] Skin & Coat Plus Response[™] FP; Royal Canin Veterinary Diet[®] Canine Selected Protein Adult[™] PV; prescribed homemade diet of tuna, brown rice, broccoli, and kale; and Royal Canin Veterinary Diet[®] Canine Anallergenic (name later changed to Royal Canin Veterinary Diet[®] Canine Ultamino[®]).

Skin condition improved only when fed the homemade diet, but voluntary intake did not meet resting caloric requirements.

INITIAL FINDINGS

- Diffuse ventral pyoderma
- Moderate to severe pruritus (6-7/10 on itch scale)

DIAGNOSIS

• Chronic allergic dermatitis

MANAGEMENT

- Switched to Blue Buffalo Natural Veterinary Diet HF Hydrolyzed for Food Intolerance (no slow transition)
- Cephalexin 20mg/kg BID x 14 days
- Additional Omega 3 Supplementation
- Weekly medicated baths

INITIAL RECHECK (14 days after starting BLUE Natural Veterinary Diet HF)

- Marked reduction of erythema
- Resolving pyoderma
- Marked improvement in pruritus
